VALAIS – ANNIVIERS AND TOURTEMAGNE – SWITZERLAND | 3 DAYS / 2 NIGHTS

DAY 1

We set off from Chandolin, a village perched above the Val d'Anniviers, with views that stop you in your tracks from the very start. The path crosses the Illgraben — a raw and slightly unsettling corridor of rock and debris, one of the largest scree cones in Europe. The day ends at Hotel Weisshorn, standing there since 1882, facing the 4000m peaks of Valais. A first stage that sets the tone immediately.

A first day that starts with legend.

Chandolin – Hotel Weisshorn

DAY 2

Today we roll up our sleeves — this is the most demanding stage of the trek. We cross the pass separating the two valleys, with a serious climb and a panorama that makes every step worth it. On the other side, the landscape turns more mineral, more wild, and we arrive at Turtmannhütte nestled in a cirque that feels truly far from everything. Your legs will know about it, but this is exactly the kind of day you talk about over dinner.

Hotel Weisshorn – Turtmannhütte

Estimated walking time 5h30

DAY 3

We leave Turtmannhütte and head deep into the wild heart of the Turtmann valley — one of the most remote corners of the Valais Alps. The path runs alongside the Brunegg glacier, an imposing mass of ice that commands respect and silence. Not many people come this way, and that's the point. The descent eventually leads to Gruben, a small village that only comes alive in summer, where a well-earned cold beer has been waiting patiently since day one.
